The talk will address the challenge of pluralism as a critical issue in the era of globalization. Dr. John Esposito is a University Professor as well as Professor of Religion and International Affairs and of Islamic Studies at Georgetown University. Dr. Esposito is also the Founding Director of the Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal Center for Muslim-Christian Understanding in the Walsh School of Foreign Service.

We advocate for human rights, separation of religious and state authorities, freedom of expression, LGBTQ rights and women's empowerment. In the short years since its inception, MPV has expanded to include chapters and affiliates in Los Angeles, New York, Washington DC, Atlanta and Philadelphia as well as in Ottawa and Toronto, Canada.

The interactive question and answer period will be moderated by Shirley Jahad, award winning journalist and Host at KPCC Public Radio. There will also be Rumi inspired artwork by Salma Arastu displayed for purchase.
